

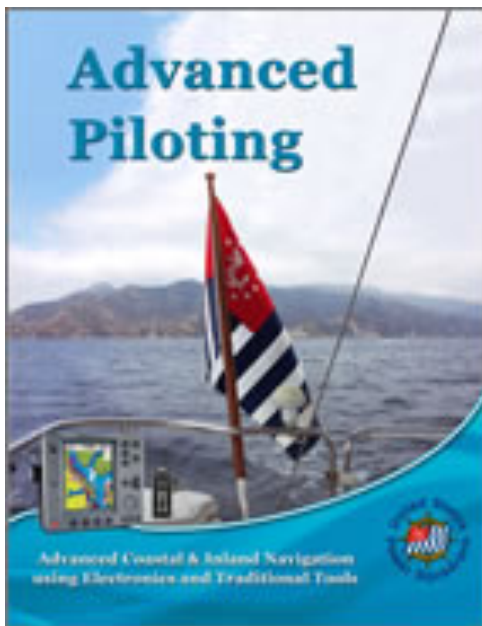
Learn to navigate on inland and coastal waters
